

# **GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS**

### OSHA Proposed Rule on Extreme Heat

On July 2<sup>nd</sup>, OSHA announced a Proposed Rule with the goal of protecting millions of indoor and outdoor workers from the significant health risks of extreme heat.

The standard would require employers to create a plan to evaluate and control heat hazards in their workplace and it would clarify employer obligations and the steps necessary to effectively protect employees from hazardous heat.
