



ASSP Honors Popov for Work on Safety Standards


On May 12th, ASSP) named Georgi Popov the recipient of the 2025 Thomas F. Bresnahan Standards Medal for his extensive work in developing and advocating voluntary national consensus standards in environmental health and safety (EHS).

Popov is a professor in the Occupational Risk and Safety Sciences Department at the University of Central Missouri. He took prevention through design from concept to reality in the development of the ANSI/ASSP Z590.3 standard, chairing the committee and being recognized as a pioneer in the field.

NIOSH Lays Off Most Remaining Staff

Nearly all of the remaining staff at the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health were laid off on May 2nd. NIOSH, an arm of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, had already stalled after an initial round of layoffs on April 1, gutting programs ranging from approvals of new safety equipment to firefighter health.

AIHA Rocky Mountain Section Encourages You to Show Your Support for NIOSH

AlHA has <u>two awareness campaigns</u> that allow you to send a letter to your U.S. Senators and Representative, in less than a minute. The first campaign is "<u>Restore</u> <u>NIOSH: Protect Worker Health and</u> <u>Safety</u>" and the second "<u>Support for</u> <u>Restoring Critical Occupational Health</u> <u>Programs in HHS</u>". NIOSH plays a vital role in safeguarding public health through research, education, and support for workplace safety initiatives. In addition to friends and colleagues impacted by these cuts, it appears that NIOSH Education Research Centers (ERCs) will likely lose funding as a result of these cuts.

Many industrial hygienists trained at an ERC and they are critical to a future IH workforce. Please contact your representatives using the links above, write your own letter, and share information about why NIOSH is critical for worker health and safety.
